The Minister will grant a High School Diploma to a student who has fulfilled the following requirements:  54 credits in Sec. IV and Sec. V 20 of these credits must be at the Sec. V level.  Of these credits, the following courses are compulsory: Sec. V Language of Instruction (English) 6 credits Sec. V French Second Language 4 or 6 credits Sec. IV History & Citizenship Education 4 credits Sec. IV Mathematics 4 or 6 credits (Cultural, Social & Technical OR Science Math)  Sec. IV Arts education 2 credits Sec. IV Science & Technology 4 credits	The graduation ceremony is a community event that allows St. Patrick's High School to grant a symbolic High School diploma.  To be eligible for this event, students must meet the MELS High School Certification standards:  AND  Students must not have failed more than two subjects. **
Sec. IV Science & Technology 4 credits  Sec. V Ethics & Religious Culture 2 credits  OR  Sec. V Physical Ed. & Health 2 credits	** The averages for the first, the second and third term will be calculated for each subject. These subject summary results will then determine whether students are failing more than two subjects.
