

DRESS CODE

Students of St. Patrick's High School are required to groom themselves in a manner that is **modest, clean, appropriate, decent and not disruptive to the educational process.**

Students are expected to abide by this dress code upon arrival to the school building through the end of the school day. The requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Hats, sunglasses, or head coverings of any kind, including bandanas and visors, may not be worn in class unless approved for religious or medical reasons. Certain headbands, barrettes, etc. which are used to hold hair in place and do not cover the entire head, are permitted.
- Shirts must cover the midriff area (bottom of shirt must meet the top of the lower attire at all times).
- Underwear / undergarments (pertaining to male and female) must be covered and not be seen.
- Cleavage area must be covered.
- Not convey messages that promote drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, violence, racial slurs or profanity.
- Skirts and shorts should not be excessively short.
- No slippers may be worn.
- School bags are not permitted in class. They are to be left in the student's locker.
- No spiked clothing or accessories.
- Shoes should always be worn.
- Aerosol deodorants are not permitted.
